08/087 TO RECEIVE THE CLERK'S REPORT

- a) **Painting of container near tennis courts, minute no 07/289, 07/405c, 08/042a –** The Community Payback scheme is still being pursued and it is hoped that the work will be started in mid July.
- b) **Floodlight installation minute no 07/408, 08/042c –** This work is now complete
- c) **CCTV minute no 08/042e refers –** This is not yet operational.
- d) **Vandalism at Fryer Field minute no 08/042 refers –** Repairs are now complete.
- e) **Dog Bin at Fryer Field minute no 08/042 refers –** this has not yet been installed.
- f) **MUGA Update minute no 08/042i refers –** A Bid for additional funding to regenerate the MUGA has now been sent to the football foundation.
- g) **Playground Repairs minute no 08/042j refers –** All work has now been completed.
- h) **Floodlight operation minute no 08/045 refers –** The lights have now been adjusted and will be on Thursday, Friday and Saturday evenings.
- i) **Overflow car park minute no 08/046 refers –** A letter has been received from EDDC stating that they want to actively support any project that is going to bring substantial community benefit, such as the proposed scheme at the Memorial Hall. The Council have stated that they would be as helpful as possible and would not unreasonably withhold its permission to develop some of its land for car parking. A letter has been sent to the Memorial Hall Council with this information.
- j) **Petwyn Planting minute no refers 08/047 –** no response has been received from the Horticultural Society with regard to the Parish Councils offer for them to provide a floral display in one of the centre flower beds on the Petwyn.
- k) **Security from Fryer Field to Station Road pathway minute no 08/048 refers –** A new gate post is due to be installed next week.
- l) **Members are informed that the electricity supply to the garage is in a bad state of repair.** The power is constantly tripping out. An electrician has looked at this and advised that the wiring requires renewing but further advised not to carry out the work until the roof has been repaired. Currently quotes are being sought for the roof repairs.
- m) Members were informed that the disabled toilet in the Pavilion was blocked and a company called out to clear the blockage.

- 08/088 TO APPROVE WORKS TO THE PAVILION AS RECOMMENDED IN THE LEGIONELLA RISK ASSESSMENT REPORT**
Members considered the quote for the remedial works to the Pavilion in order to comply with the legionella risk assessment report and it was
RESOLVED to carry out the works as per the quote provided by Pipefix .
- 08/089 TO CONSIDER THE INSTALLATION OF A GATE IN THE HEDGE LINE BETWEEN THE MAIN FRYER FIELD AND THE AREA BY THE MUGA**
Members felt that as the main gate to Fryer Field is currently locked at dusk and that the gate that is sited along the footpath that leads to Station Road from the children's play area is also to be locked at dusk it was a sensible option to secure the main fryer field further by the installation of a gate in the hedge line separating the two sections of the Fryer field area. It was felt that this would act as a deterrent to people who currently ride motorcycles in the Fryer Field. It would also go some way to securing the play area at night and therefore may reduce vandalism in the area.
RESOLVED to install a 5 bar wooden gate in the hedge line between the main fryer field and the area of playing field by the MUGA. Clerk to arrange.
