10/109 PINEHURST PARADE INFORMATION

Members discussed a proposal for displaying information regarding the condition of Pinehurst Parade and the ownership of the land.

RESOLVED that the Parish Council identify and write to each land owner reminding them of their responsibilities towards the upkeep of the access road also to inform them of the number of complaints the Parish Council has received from the general public in respect of the poor condition of this road. If improvements are not carried out the Parish Council will put up a notice stating that any claims for injuries sustained as a result of the condition of the road should be directed to the land owners.

10/110 ASHURST ROAD/ARNOLD CLOSE INSTALLATION OF MOTORCYCLE INHIBITORS

Dorset County council requested comments from the Parish Council on the removal of the pedestrian gates and the installation of motorcycle inhibitors on the Ashurst Road/Arnold Close footpath. Dorset County Council have proposed these changes as the pedestrian gates are causing inconvenience for the local residents due to the noise the gates make when they are opened and closed. It was

RESOLVED that the Parish Council are in favour of the installation of the motorcycle inhibitors on the footpath.

- c) Cllr Mrs C Holmes informed members of a telephone call from Mrs Legrand regarding the azaleas and a tree on the Petwyn which appear to be dying. After discussion it was agreed that the groundsman would water the Petwyn twice a week during the dry spell.

- e) Cllr P Holden asked members if they would be interested in attending possible meetings with regards to Council funds for footpaths
