**09/400 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST**

Cllr Ms S Edwards declared a personal interest in agenda item 5, allotments.

**09/401 TO RECEIVE CLERKS REPORT**

**a) Oakhurst Play area minute no 09/328, 09/367a refers** – The work to install the new play equipment has now been completed and bark top up will be ordered shortly. The Parish Council has submitted a grant application to the Big Lottery fund toward the cost of installing the new play equipment at Fryer Field.

**b) Christmas competition minute no 09/371 refers** – the competition packs have been delivered to the schools

**d) Oakhurst gatekeeper** – A new gatekeeper has been found for the Oakhurst Play area

**e) Petwyn trees minute no 09/369 refers** – Still awaiting additional quotes

**f) Bus shelter minute no 09/374 refers** – Transdev have now installed timetables into Parish Council bus shelters. The bus shelter opposite Queens Close has now been repaired. These repairs were carried out by the lengthsman. The possibility of a replacement bus shelter opposite Queens close is being investigated.

**g) Cllr Finney** has informed the Parish Council that some potholes in Pinehurst Road have been repaired.

**h) Mr Steve Hunt** has approached the Parish Council and asked if the Youth Club can apply for grants in order to have lights installed in the trees on the Petwyn. Clerk to work with Mr Hunt on this matter.

**09/402 ALLOTMENT WORKING PARTY UPDATE**

Members received a verbal update from Cllr Ms S Edwards. The Allotment Holders association would like to proceed with the land located behind Brook View. An ecological survey is required before any work can proceed as this is a requirement of EDDC who own the land. The Clerk to ask EDDC what qualifications are required by the person carrying out an ecological survey and to then obtain quotes and bring back to committee.

**09/403 WEST MOORS CRICKET CLUB**

After a brief discussion it was

**RESOLVED that the West Moors Cricket Club could replace their container located at Fryer Field with one the same size as the Parish Council container (20ft). Both containers are to be painted the same colour (green).**

Members discussed a report from Cllr's Holden and Holmes on the issue of Dog Control orders on the Fryer Field and the finding of the EDDC scrutiny and policy committee meeting held on the 30<sup>th</sup> March. The dog warden is now patrolling the Fryer Field and will be able to enforce fouling rules. Members discussed the need for more signage. After a discussion it was

**RESOLVED to monitor the situation and revisit the idea of excluding dogs from the marked sports pitches if it is felt that a major problem has arisen.**
