08/316 TO RECEIVE THE CLERK'S REPORT

- a) **War Memorial works minute no 08/59, 08/117e, 08/220b refers** – These works are now complete and residents have commended the installation of the bollards.
- b) **Litter at the Library minute no 08/057g refers** – A litter bin has now been installed
- c) **Notice board for Pinehurst Shops minute no 08/060 refers** – The board at Pinehurst Road has now been installed
- d) **Pedestrian Crossing in Station Road minute no 08/221 refers** - Dorset County Council will be carrying out surveys and results should be available in January. DCC have approved a School Crossing Patrol for St Mary's School and are currently advertising for the position.
- e) **Bus Shelters minute no 08/223 refers** – Seats for the bus shelters have been ordered after the additional expenditure was approved at the Finance and GP committee.
- f) **Speed Indicator Devices** – No Further information at this time. Waiting for a response from Dorset County Council re placement of poles for SID's.
- g) **Additional Street Lighting in Moorlands Road minute no 08/226 refers** – DCC have received the request and it will be scored and ranked, if the score is high enough the additional lighting will be considered.
- h) **Memorial Hall Minute no 08/225d refers** - The Memorial Hall has now been marked on the map.
- i) **Street Lighting Belle Vue Grove minute no 08/220h** – DCC have assessed the site as high priority and will produce a lighting design. The Parish Council fully supports the installation of the additional lighting.
